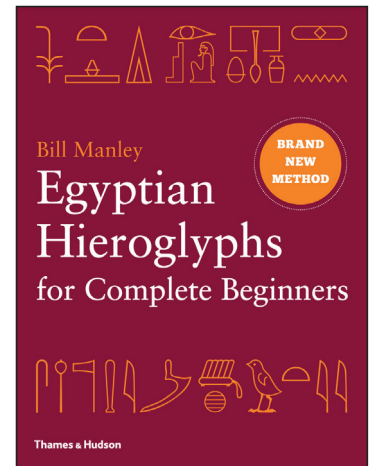
Assuming no particular knowledge of any foreign language, ancient or modern, Manley's technique is founded on twenty-five years' experience of teaching hieroglyphs to students.
